G. MEMBERSHIP UPDATE (Christy)

- iv. The National AIHA will begin collecting dues for 2022 in October 2021. Section Members that are also Natl. AIHA Members are encouraged to pay their dues through National when they renew. Local Section Dues reports are available to LS Treasurer through Catalyst Profile and updated on a monthly basis at the end of the month.

**Treasurer's Report for AIHA Executive Committee Meeting
Wednesday, July 28, 2021**

All materials have been sent to Paula Sweitzer, who will conduct our internal annual audit. An official Auditor's Verification letter will be sent once completed.

In the fiscal year of 2021, we generated \$8,035.00 in revenue, and \$5,538.29 in expenses, giving us a bank balance of \$8,965.81, resulting in a net **gain** of \$2,496.71. Here's the breakdown:
