- In the fiscal year of 2017, we generated \$12,916.00 in revenue, and \$14,487.99 in expenses, giving us a bank balance of \$7,789.42, resulting in a net loss of \$1,571.99. As compared to last year, our revenue increased by \$796.00, and our expenses increased by \$3,353.50.
